## 3. The types of stones permitted

**Memorial stones need to be flat, rustic in shape and laid flat to the ground.** Local field or river stones are ideal - one that you have sourced and collected yourself or which your craftsman has identified on which the name and dates of the deceased are cut. In keeping with the wild and natural character of the burial ground, no square cut or polished stones should be placed.

The stone should be laid flat to the ground and no larger than 45cm x 45cm (18 inches square). Letter cutting can be undertaken by a family member, local stonemason or memorial mason. In keeping with the natural setting, no paint should be used in the letters.

The position for the stone will be measured out and flagged for you to set the stone in place.
